

HKV RFPD Chief Report June 17, 2026

Calls this period

May 23 - Wildland Fire - Mutual Aid - Philomath - Slash fire, less than an acre in size. Eli, Seth and Adam responded in 562 with Philomath, Alsea, Monroe and ODF.

May 23 - Medical - Maxfield Creek - Chest pain. Rebekah, Ben, Seth, Eli and Rachael responded with Philomath and Corvallis. The patient refused transport.

May 26 - Medical - Mutual Aid - Polk County - Gunshot wound. Mark, Eli, Rebekah and Seth responded. Patient deceased prior to arrival.

June 1 - Brush Fire - Hwy 223 - Burn pile that spread to surrounding brush, ¼ acre in size. Rebekah, Adam, Nick, Mark, Eli and Seth responded with 562, 541, 563, and 531 with Philomath, Polk and ODF.

June 14 - Fire - All County Response - Philomath - Burn pile under control. Seth, Eli, Rebekah and Adam responded, but cancelled while at station.

June 14 - Fire - All County Response - Corvallis - Amazon truck on fire, spread to trees. Seth and Eli responded, but were turned around at Wren.
